pontoise impressionist artists and their homes are inseparably linked for each home meant something slightly different a place of comfort in a rapidly shifting society a sanctuary immune to changing fortunes and fame a simpler way of life away from the city a place to express their individuality and to entertain in every case it shaped their art organized around the artists daily routines eating socializing working bathing sleeping relaxing raising children this book explores the home lives of the impressionists as never before drawing on their paintings diaries letters reminiscences intimate sketches and family photographs it charts the turbulence and tranquility of the artists private lives considering their attitudes to relationships family interior decoration money and their art book jacket

villa langmatt at baden may well be considered one of the gems among swiss private collections open to the public in 1908 the entrepreneurs and married couple sidney and jenny brown started to assemble the first impressionist collection in switzerland which is still being presented in its original living space setting until this day starting with camille corot and eugene boudin it includes works by edgar degas claude monet auguste renoir camille pissarro and alfred sisley as well as paul cezanne and paul gauguin there are also some works by gustave courbet henri fantin latour odilon redon and the france based american artist mary cassatt the collection is rounded off by a few 18th century canvasses

this volume seeks to reframe french impressionist painter berthe morisot 1841 95 in the history of art via a focus on the spaces and people that informed her work and thereby offers a new interpretation of impressionism and of modernist aesthetics claire moran utilizes close visual analyses of artworks in particular those of family friends domestic servants and

acquaintances textual analysis of morisot's journals and letters investigation of late nineteenth century advice manuals magazines and advertisements in relation to morisot's life and work examination of housing floor plans and gardens and the study of specific household objects that recur in her work and their history this multi pronged method of analysis grounded in morisot's lived experience will allow a new understanding of morisot's art to emerge one with the potential to not only highlight the modernity of her aesthetics but also question both public and critical assumptions about impressionism the book will be of interest to scholars working in art history gender studies french studies and history of design

manet monet pissarro cézanne renoir degas sisley berthe morisot and mary cassatt though they were often ridiculed or ignored by their contemporaries astonishing sums are paid today for the works of these artists their dazzling pictures are familiar but how well does the world know the impressionists as people in a vivid and moving narrative biographer sue roe shows the impressionists in the studios of paris rural lanes of montmartre and rowdy riverside bars as paris underwent baron haussman's spectacular transformation for over twenty years they lived and worked together as a group struggling to rebuild their lives after the franco prussian war and supporting one another through shocked public reactions to unfamiliar canvasses depicting laundresses dancers spring blossom and boating scenes this intimate colourful superbly researched account takes us into their homes as well as their studios and describes their unconventional volatile and precarious lives as well as the stories behind their paintings

this book describes the development of impressionism and presents the eleven artists who made up the impressionist group including reproductions and analyses of their work

charles baudelaire's flâneur as described in his 1863 essay the painter of modern life remains central to understandings of gender space and the gaze in late nineteenth century paris despite misgivings by some scholars baudelaire's privileged and leisurely figure at home on the boulevards underlies theorizations of bourgeois masculinity and by implication bourgeois femininity whereby men gaze and roam urban spaces unreservedly while women lacking the freedom to either gaze or roam are wedded to domesticity in challenging this tired paradigm and offering fresh ways to consider how gender space and the gaze were constructed this book attends to several neglected elements of visual and written culture the ubiquitous male beggar as the true denizen of the boulevard the abundant depictions of well to do women looking sometimes at men the popularity of windows and balconies as viewing perches and the

overwhelming emphasis given by both male and female artists to domestic scenes the book's premise that gender space and the gaze have been too narrowly conceived by a scholarly embrace of baudelaire's flâneur is supported across the cultural spectrum by period sources that include art criticism high and low visual culture newspapers novels prescriptive and travel literature architectural practices interior design trends and fashion journals

the home is for many people the location for their most intense relationships with visual things because they are constructed through the objects we choose domestic spaces are deeply revealing of a range of cultural issues how is our interpretation of an object affected by the domestic environment in which it is placed why choose a stainless steel teapot over a leopard print one how do the images hanging on the walls of our homes arrive there in placing contemporary art in the context of the ordinary home this book embarks on the contentious topic of whether high art impacts on ordinary people what is the size and nature of the audience for contemporary art in britain do people really visit more art galleries than attend football matches what is the significance of the home in relation to such questions indeed what constitutes art in the home this book carefully unpicks these questions as well as the troubled relationship between the home as a place of comfort and reassurance and the often unsettling and challenging images offered by contemporary art within the art world the home has been addressed as a subject and even used as a temporary gallery and a space for installations and yet it is not common for works by today's avant garde artists to be conceived and marketed to participate in the domestic lives that most people live handsomely illustrated this book unites contemporary art craft and design with sociology anthropology and cultural studies to provide an unusual and forthright addition to ongoing art and culture debates

where is my home the art and life of the russian jewish sculptor mark antokolskii 1843 1902 is the first full length study in english of the art and life of mark antokolskii the widely recognized russian and european sculptor of the late 19th century an originator of novel trends in sculpture in its transition to modernism antokolskii was the first artist of jewish origin to attend the academy of art in st petersburg and to become an honorable member of the russian and western intellectual milieu participating in many international world exhibitions he received numerous awards including the legion d honneur 1878 paris antokolskii was a member of many european academies of art and his works are in museums and private collections worldwide where is my home focuses on antokolski's artistic uniqueness and his fate as a jewish intellectual who belongs to distinct cultures musyagants pays particular attention to antokolski's constant struggle between his devotion to russia and the lifelong commitment to his people this opens ways to discuss less known aspects of the notions of national identity and spiritual duality it is an attempt to give an account of the artist as a notable jewish social and cultural figure a thinker and essayist whose art reveals his longing for people's reconciliation and overcoming of historical alienation

defining an artistic era or movement is often a difficult task as one tries to group individualistic expressions and artwork under one broad brush such is the case with impressionism which culls together the art of a multitude of painters in the mid 19th century including monet cézanne renoir degas and van gogh basically impressionism involved the shedding of traditional painting methods the subjects of art were taken from everyday life as opposed to the pages of mythology and history in addition each artist painted to express feelings of the moment instead of hewing to time honoured standards this description of impressionism obviously is quite broad and can apply to a wide array of styles nonetheless it remains a very important school in the annals of art any current or budding art aficionado should become familiar with the impressionist movement and its impact on the art world this book presents a sweeping study of this artistic period from its origins to its manifestations in the works of some of art history's most revered painters following this overview is a substantial and selective bibliography featuring access through author title and subject indexes

late in his career claude monet returned to london to paint the fog that had entranced him years before the resulting sequence of pictures represents some of the fascination that french painters felt for britain similarly many british collectors and young painters embraced and were influenced by the work of the french impressionists this book describes the activities of the french impressionist painters on their visits to britain considers the dissemination of impressionist painting through british dealers and collectors explores the response of artists from britain and ireland to the impressionist movement and sets all of these against the backdrop of late victorian and edwardian britain mcconkey and robins describe the work of monet pissarro sisley and other impressionists working in london showing how this art influenced the community of young british painters disenchanted with british art schools and art exhibiting standards the

authors investigate the role played by two innovative painters who were american expatriates james mcneill whistler and john singer sargent and they explain how such artists as william orpen george clausen stanhope forbes henry la thangue walter sickert and philip wilson steer sought out new and radical approaches to picture making formed new secessionist art societies and articulated new concepts of the role of art rejecting historical pageants and fashionable aestheticism and focusing on modern rural and urban conditions the book is the catalogue of an exhibition that will be at the barbican art gallery in london from january to march 1995 and then move to dublin

two arab men are found murdered near downtown houston texas and detectives ross clayton and leona stillwell are sent to investigate these aren t ordinary murders however the bodies are arranged to mirror a famous impressionist painting and the exactitude of the killing gives clayton cause to be concerned he suspects this killer isn t finished his suspicions turn out to be correct as more men end up dead and similarly arranged every victim is of arab descent and it s hard to deny the killer must have both some kind of racial vendetta and a love for impressionist art clayton and his partner have no choice but to seek out an expert lund corbel from the houston fine arts museum he sets them on the right path but their path gets crowded as the serial killer continues the spree clayton has solved plenty of strange crimes before but he s beginning to feel out of his depth especially following the death of a fellow cop in pursuit of another investigation involving drugs prostitution and murder soon two investigations collide and the end won t be as pretty as a painting

impressionists and politics is an accessible introduction to the current debates about impressionism was the artistic movement really radical and innovative is the term impressionism itself an adequate characterization of the movement of painters and critics that took the mid nineteenth century paris art world by storm by providing an historical background and context the book places the impressionists roots in wider social and economic transformations and explains its militancy both aesthetic and political impressionists and politics is a concise history of the movement from its youthful inception in the 1860s through to its final years of recognition and then crisis

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
