- **Project: Support to the Electoral Cycle 2009-2012**
- ☐ Aims to develop capacity of Electoral Commission of Zambia (ECZ) and Department of National Registration, Passport and Citizenship Office (DNRPC) and Non-State Actors
- **Total Funding Pledged: USD19,810,416** 
  - ☐ ECZ- USD 3.596M
  - ☐ DNRPC- USD 2M
  - ☐ European Commission- USD 9.62M
  - ☐ Canada- USD 2.12M
  - □ Netherlands- USD 1.3M
  - ☐ Finland- USD 247,074

## Voter Registration Planning Stage

### **Funding and Procurement**

- **Budget allocated for procuring** of 1,000 Mobile Registration Kits- USD2,850,000
- **Procurement** arrangement delegated **UNDP** to and undertaken by PSO

#### **EMB's Planning**

- ☐ ECZ: Public Info Dissemination Voter Continuous of Registration to begin in October for 90 days
- ☐ ECZ: Advocating and lobbying through MPs for additional funding over K70 Billion to fully implement CVR
