It means independence from ruling party and government.

Independent functions in terms of organization, tasks, human resources, budget allocation etc.



Establishment of the Association of World Election Bodies (A-WEB)


- For the enhancement and development of democracy across the world, it is important for EMBs to cooperate and make global efforts.
